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Examining the Challenges of Growing Up and Becoming a Father, *The Beetle* follows an Israeli Man Struggling to Say Goodbye to His Beloved Volkswagen

(San Francisco, CA) – With fatherhood quickly approaching, Israeli filmmaker Yishai Orian must wrestle with a decision: Should he keep his beloved 40-year-old Volkswagen Beetle or trade it in for something more reliable? His mechanic says that the car won't last long, and his wife complains that it's unsuitable for a baby. In an attempt to keep the Beetle that he adores, Orian goes on a journey that begins with visiting the car's previous owners, continues to Jordan for discount renovations, and ends with the birth of his first child. The director's personal story begins to blend with the exciting, funny, sad, and intimate memories of the Beetle's previous owners as these individuals bond over their mutual love for the car. *The Beetle* will premiere nationally on PBS WORLD's *Global Voices*, an international themed documentary series, on Sunday, July 4 at 10 PM (check local listings).
